Three-day professional visit by students of the Faculty of Technology from Novi Sad

As part of the CEEPUS network HR-0306 *For Healthy Food in Middle Europe*, coordinated by Prof. Sandra Budžaki Ph.D. from the Faculty of Food Technology in Osijek, a professional visit of PhD students (two female students) and graduate students in Food Engineering (24 students) from the Faculty of Technology in Novi Sad took place, accompanied by 4 teachers.

During their visit to Osijek, a tour entitled *A fusion of tradition and technology* was organized for the students, during which they visited the leading oil factory of the Republic of Croatia in Čepin and the brewery in Osijek, the first Croatian brewery with more than 350 years of experience. No less important was the visit to the sweet story, the confectionery factory, the famous Kandit, which began its work in the 1920s. What not only Osijek, but also Croatia, can boast of is the largest wine barrel in the world, which is still used for wine production and is located in the winery in Erdut. For the fellow students from Novi Sad, it was also an unmissable stop with a tasting. During a visit to the wastewater treatment plant in Vukovar, the students were able to gain an impression of the latest technological achievements in the field of wastewater treatment as an indispensable link in environmental protection.



The excursion took place from May 27 to 29, 2024. During their stay in Osijek, the students and teachers were accommodated in a new student residence.
